**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this policy is to outline the helmet colors and markings for all stations.

**BACKGROUND:** This was a verbal policy passed by the Chiefs Committee at an earlier date.

**SCOPE:** This policy applies to all Rappahannock County fire, rescue, and/or emergency medical services stations

## **POLICY:**

1. Helmet Color

•	Chief Fire Officers	WHITE
•	E.M.S. Chief Officers with Fire Officer Training	WHITE
•	Fire Captain	WHITE
٠	E.M.S. Captain with Fire Officer Training	WHITE
•	Fire Lieutenant	WHITE
•	E.M.S. Lieutenant with Fire Officer Training	WHITE
•	Firefighters	YELLOW & BLACK
•	Non SCBA Firefighters	RED
•	Emergency Medical/Rescue Personnel	ORANGE
•	Emergency Medical/Rescue Officers	BLUE

2. Helmet Markings

• Front shield and rocker specifications on helmets are determined at the station level.

## 3. Junior Personnel

- Junior Personnel who have met the requirements as established by the Rappahannock County Board of Supervisors and the Rappahannock County Fire and Rescue Association may be issued a YELLOW helmet with "JUNIOR FIREFIGHTER" rockers on each side of the helmet.
- In summary, as established by the aforementioned bodies, Junior Firefighters issued YELLOW helmets must have successfully completed Firefighter I and have permission from his/her parents/guardian and station officers to participate.
