**PURPOSE:**

To establish a method for identifying the personnel that are responding to the station or scene for an emergency event.

**BACKGROUND:**

**DEFINITIONS:**

**I Am Responding (IAR)** Program used to show available personnel and personnel responding to an emergency incident.

**POLICY:**

Personnel should utilize IAR to show their response to emergency calls.

Communications may suspend the 5 minute time limit for redispach if they deem that a crew is enrout to the station from 12 am to 6 am.

If they deem a unit does not have a crew responding to the station they will maintain the 5 minute time limit for that company.

If a unit has not responded that has marked on IAR as having a crew by 8 minutes they shall be redispached, and have a replacement unit sent in its place.
